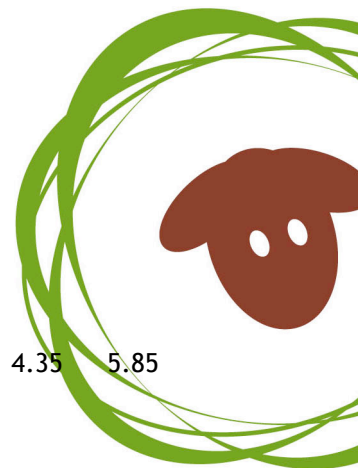

<b>Indomita Carmenere, Chile</b> A medium bodied red from a small independent winery. A fine example of good new world wine.			16.95
